

## APPLICATION FOR BURN PERMIT

**Permit shall expire 30 days after date of issuance.**

**Materials to be burned: the only material allowed to be burned are tree limbs with attached leaves. The limbs must be less than six inches in diameter and eight feet in length (also referred to as brush).**

#### **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- 1) Saratoga County Fire Control shall be notified before starting and upon completion of all fires by calling 518-885-5522.**
- 2) The Approved Burn Permit must be in the possession of the applicant at the burn site during the duration of the burning.**
- 3) Only the on-site burning of tree limbs with attached leaves is allowed. The limbs must be less than six inches in diameter and eight feet in length (also referred to as brush). No other materials may be burned.**
- 4) Burning is prohibited during high winds.**
- 5) Burning will only be conducted between sunrise and sunset.**
- 6) The location for an open fire shall not be less than 50 feet from any structure and provisions shall be made to prevent the fire from spreading to within 50 feet of any structure.**
- 7) The open fire shall be constantly attended until the fire is fully extinguished.**
- 8) A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher complying with the Fire Code of New York State with a minimum 4-A rating or other approved on-site fire-extinguishing equipment such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose or fire apparatus shall be available for immediate utilization.**
- 9) The applicant must allow access to the property of the burn site to the Town of Stillwater Code Enforcement Officer, Town of Stillwater Fire Marshal, Members of the Arvin Hart Fire Company or any Police Officer.**
- 10) The applicant must extinguish the fire upon request of the Town of Stillwater Code Enforcement Officer, Town of Stillwater Fire Marshal, Members of the Arvin Hart Fire Company or any Police Officer.**
