

Board of Directors



Community Benefit

As part of the development agreement for Fab 8, GLOBALFOUNDRIES contributed \$1,000,000 to fund the Foundation. The company contributed to this fund in installments, marked by key milestones towards the successful construction and start of operations of Fab 8. The Foundation was fully funded in July 2012. The funds will be held in a special escrow account to provide funding for projects providing tangible and measureable benefits to the Town.

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Requests for Funding Guidelines

The GLOBALFOUNDRIES-Stillwater Foundation currently has \$1,000,000 in Principle and approximately \$2,800 in interest available for investments in the community. Current by-laws allow expenditures from interest earnings. A super majority vote may allow expenditures from principle; but can be subject to Town Board approval. The Foundation Board of Directors is pursuing a change to the By-law policies to increase funding availability.

Based on the current and potential changes to funding policies, community organizations identified below are encouraged to submit applications to be considered for funding grants. In order to increase the acceptance rate for grant awards, a Matching 1:1, or Challenge Grant may be awarded in certain cases. GFSF anticipates awarding grants in a single sum by certified check in the fiscal year 2013.

The Board of Directors will look for projects that are creative, innovative, and inclusive in their scope and opportunities that will provide the maximum amount of benefit to the local Stillwater community. The Board of Directors will determine the specific size of individual grants and which organizations, initiatives, or projects receive grants.


Organizations and individuals seeking funding must complete a funding application and return it to:

Requests for funding must be received no later than February 28, each year. Determination of successful recipients will be made in the spring of 2013 with distribution completed within three months. GFSF anticipates that the period of performance for grants awarded in fiscal year 2013 will be completed in a reasonable time frame depending on the scope of the effort. Work must commence within six months. All award recipients will be required to submit a brief narrative to Global Foundries- Stillwater Foundation explaining program progress commencing six months to-the-day award is granted. Please note no additional funds will be awarded until the initial grant has been completed.

Renewed funding depends upon re-application and evaluation. Visitation to sites may be requested along with additional information.

- Be able to demonstrate the ability to provide tangible benefits of a public nature to diverse groups located in whole or in part within the Town of Stillwater including, but not limited to:


- ✓ Not-for-profit corporations






