A Resolution to Adopt Year End Budget Transfers and Corrections

Introduced	by:	Supervisor

WHEREAS, certain year end budget transfers and corrections to contingent appropriations should be undertaken to maximize the use of 2023 appropriated funds; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Fiscal Management will work with the Supervisor to finalize all transactions for fiscal close-out, ensure the necessary transfer and use of unexpended balances to balance the 2023 budget, make corrections to contingent appropriations with the 2023 budget, adjust the distribution of sales tax revenues between B and DB Funds, as required by the board, and encumber the necessary funds to pay unpaid 2023 obligations.

RESOLUTION NO. 78

A Resolution Increasing Ambulance Billing Rates for 2024

Introduced by: <u>Supervisor</u>

WHEREAS, the Malta-Stillwater EMS has requested approval of its billing rate increases of 5% for patients it transports in 2024; and

WHEREAS, the EMS's equipment and operations have been increasing in cost since the last rate increase in 2022.

NOW, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby approves the following ambulance billing rate increases for the Malta-Stillwater EMS effective January 1, 2024 as follows:

Mileage: \$24 to \$25/mile

Basic Life Support Transport: \$1000 to \$1050 Advanced Life Support Transport: \$1275 to \$1339 Advanced Life Support 2 Intercept: \$1475 to \$1549 Advanced Life Support Intercept: \$500 to \$525 Specialty Care Transport: \$2500 to \$2625 Refused Medical Aid/Transport: \$50 to \$55

Advanced Life Support Refused Medical Aid/Transport: \$200 to \$210 Motor Vehicle Accident Refused Medical Aid/Transport: \$500 to \$525

RESOLUTION NO. 79

A Resolution Approving the Purchase of Highway Equipment

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent has recommended the purchase of a 2023 Gradall XL4100 off NYS OGS contract PC69150, which does not require competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price will not exceed \$522,000.00 and will be paid for out of 2024 Budgeted funds.

NOW, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby approves of the purchase of a 2023 Gradall XL4100 from NYS OGS contract PC69150 at a purchase price not to exceed \$522,000.00, to be paid for from 2024 Budgeted funds.

RESOLUTION NO. 80

Introduced by: Supervisor

A Resolution Authorizing the Supervisor to Enter into a Contract and Lease with the Stillwater Area Community Services Center

WHEREAS, the Stillwater Area Community Services Center (hereafter "SACC") conducts
various educational, recreational, and social programs for the residents of the Town of
Stillwater; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Stillwater owns and maintains the building that houses the SACC; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that the activities conducted by the SACC are of benefit to the residents of the Town of Stillwater; and

WHEREAS, each year the Town Budget appropriates funds for the support of programs provided by and through the SACC; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed the contract and approves of its execution.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized to enter into a Contract and Lease with the Stillwater Area Community Center, Inc. for the distribution of Town funds as approved in the Final 2024 Town Budget to the SACC for the years 2023-2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the disbursement of funds shall occur contemporaneously with the filing of an annual financial report by the SACC with the Town Board.
